Mineral County is currently not mandating masks; however, like the hospital some businesses may choose to require masks.

- •The health and safety of our patients and our workforce has always been and continues to be our top priority. It is our duty as healthcare providers to protect them.
- Like other hospitals throughout the nation, MCH has followed CDC guidelines for the protection our patients. The CDC continues to recommend that all people 2 years of age and older wear a face covering in public settings.
- •We will continue to follow the CDC guidance by requiring staff, patients, and visitors to wear a face always covering within any of our facilities. We provide medical grade face masks to patients and visitors when they enter our facilities.
- •Healthcare facilities are unique since the patients we care for are vulnerable to the spread of the virus. Asking our staff, visitors, and patients to wear masks is a simple way we can keep everyone safe.
- Unfortunately, this pandemic is NOT over, and we need to continue taking precautions – washing hands, social distancing, and wearing masks – to prevent the spread of the virus.
